#### IT OVERSIGHT

and why we need to talk about it

- Seventh-day Adventist organizations' IT personnel/ support varies considerably
- Most organizations lack an oversight system, exposing individuals and their organizations to significant risks
- Concerns expressed at multiple levels regarding the need for consistency in IT standards, oversight, and potential assessments and audits





#### GCAS IT SERVICES

#### Proposal

- GCAS seeks to provide information technology (IT) services, as permissible under the International and U.S. Standards for attest clients
- Our commitment includes exploring opportunities including
  IT assessments and IT audits based on client needs
- GCAS does not plan to provide penetration testing or system implementation testing

- GCAS IT Audits (includes opinion where deemed necessary)






#### TSC\* RESPONSIBILITIES: BEST PRACTICES

Practices should consider different SDA "industries"











#### TSC\* RESPONSIBILITIES: RATINGS

#### TSC\* RESPONSIBILITIES: STANDARDS

TSC\* to develop the IT Standards

- They are the subject matter experts and understand the church, administrative approaches, and budget limitations
- Determine which framework to utilize based on industry standard, organization size, and risk appetite

## TSC\* & IT DEPT. RESPONSIBILITIES: SELF-ASSESSMENT

- Self-assessment checklist to be developed by TSC\*
- Self-Assessment to be performed by each organization or as determined by TSC\*
- Completed checklists to be shared with the appropriate parties (i.e., Administration, Audit Committee, Governance, etc.)





#### GCAS RESPONSIBILITIES

- Offer IT Assessment services to SDA organizations (no opinion is provided)
- When the appropriate standards are in place, offer IT Audit services





#### NEXT STEPS - TSC\*

- Determine the appropriate framework(s) to use as an organization
- Develop the IT Standards to aid in the Assessment process (self and external)
- **3** Collaboration with GCAS





#### NEXT STEPS - GCAS

- GCAS Board approved concept (2/11/2024)
- RFP to appropriate consultants to build an IT Assessment & Audit program (June August 2024)
- Build & recommend a cost recovery framework for these services (October 2024)
- 4 Collaborate with GC & Division IT Directors & Treasury
